Wild berries

Salmonberries mid-June to July

Check out the woodland trails in Seattle's Seward Park, Burien's Seahurst Park and along the [Cougar Mountain](#) Trail. [Church Creek](#) is known for early-season salmonberries.

Thimbleberries mid-July to August

Thimbleberries are typically found in similar locations as Salmonberries, so hit the parks!

Blackberries August to September

Huckleberries mid-August to September

Pick a park or hiking trail (Cougar Mountain Trail is a good bet) and keep your eyes peeled. You may also find huckleberries in Seattle's Seward Park.
